For over 10 years, College Bound AZ has been serving low-income families with services to support students who want to go to college. Our services began with an initial seven middle school children in Mesa, AZ. Soon after, it was recognized that services to support the journey to college were needed in high school. From the initial seven students, College Bound AZ has served over 3,000 students in 11 school districts to help students with career development, apply to college, complete financial aid applications, and learn budget basics.



MISSION

College Bound AZ, a nonprofit community resource, shares the journey to college with aspiring under-represented students through mentorship, guidance, and support resources for their advancement to a better future through education. College Bound AZ helps families overcome the hidden barriers to education success such as food scarcity, medical needs, or parents working multiple jobs so that the opportunity for higher education reaches all levels of society.


